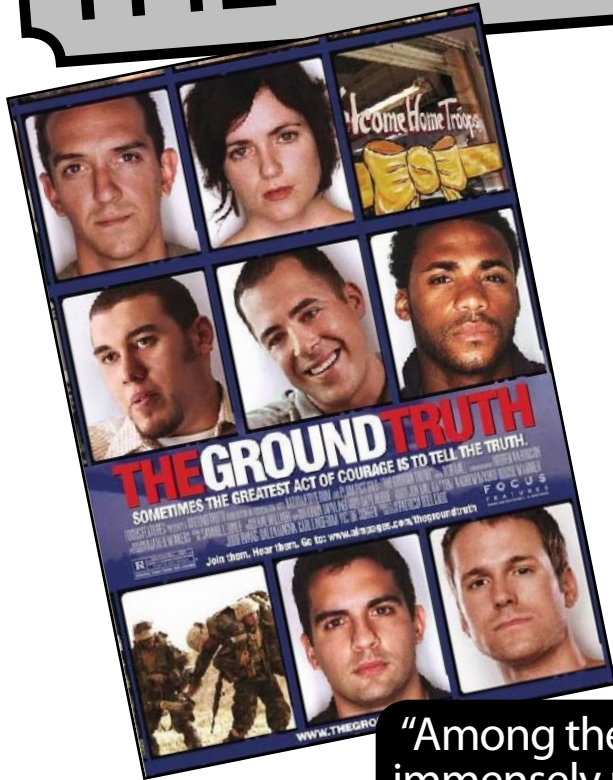

The Movie will be followed up with a panel discussion. Panel Members include:

Joe Godfrey - Father of three Army veterans, two of whom served in combat in Iraq and Afghanistan. His eldest son returned from Iraq in 2004 and shortly thereafter was granted a medical retirement, suffering from symptoms of PTSD.

Mike Blake - Enlisted in 2001 to serve his country and earn money for college. Served in the 4th Infantry Division in Iraq from April 2003 - March 2004. He applied for conscientious objector status and received an honorable discharge in 2004. Currently a student at SUNY-Cortland.

Bill Cross - West Point Graduate and Viet Nam veteran from Sept. 64 - Sept. 65. Awarded the Combat Infantryman's Badge and two medals for valor. Left the military as a Major - last 3 years teaching leadership at West Point. Currently a Prof. of Psychology at OCC. In private practice Bill helps veterans with stress disorders and their families.
